



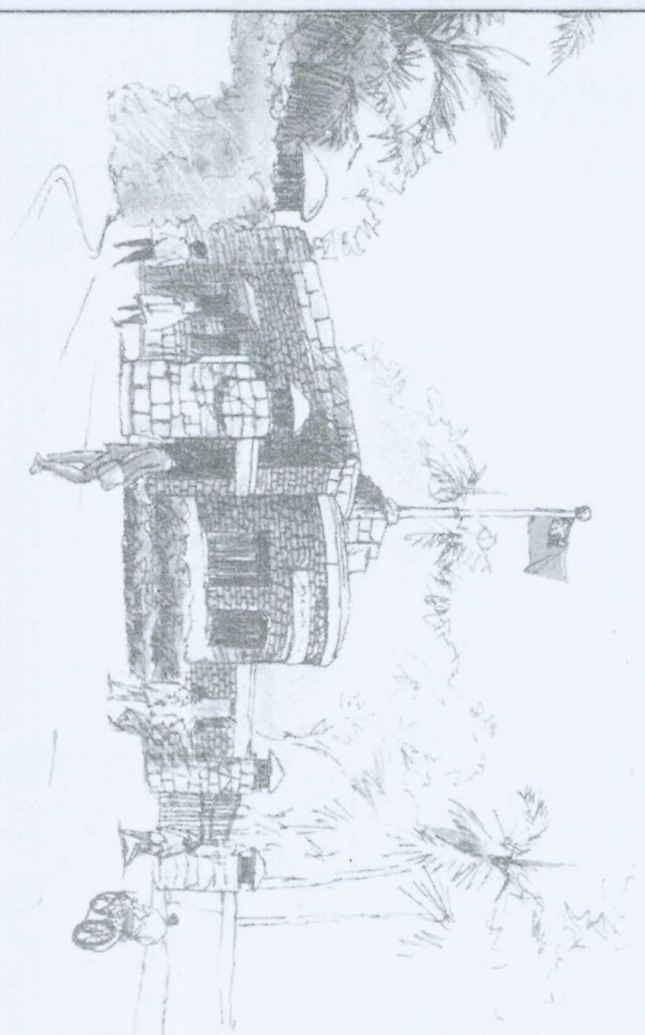

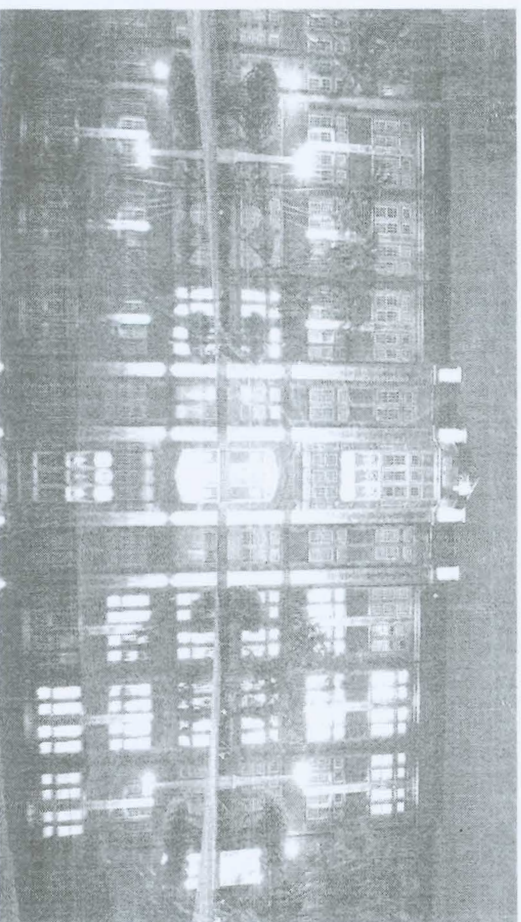

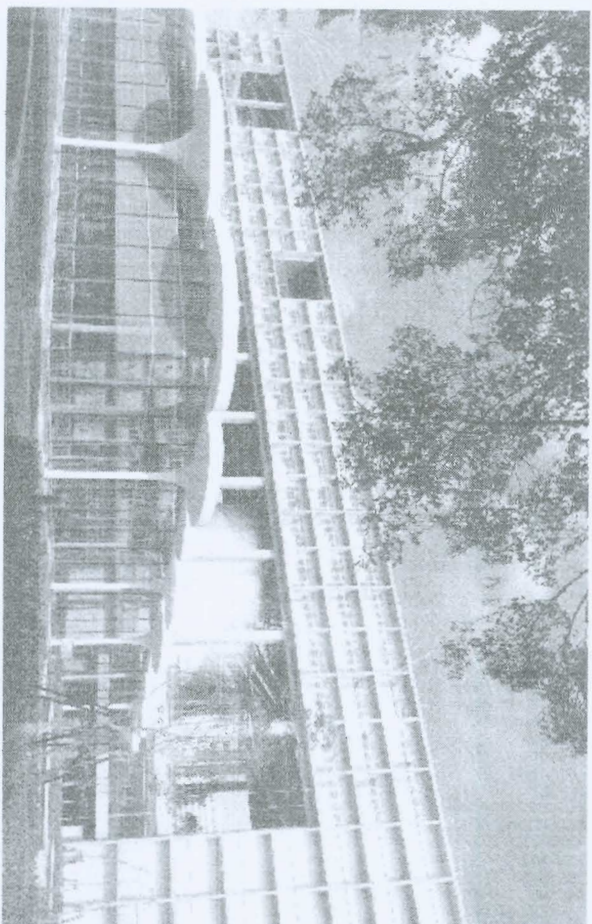
Natural Science

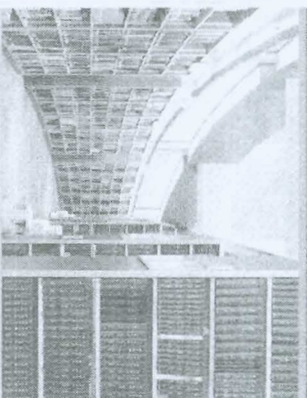
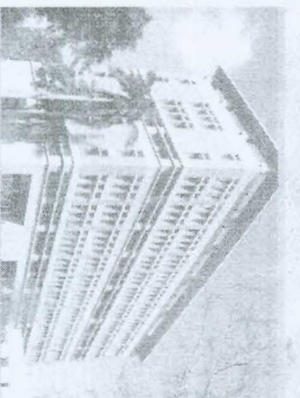

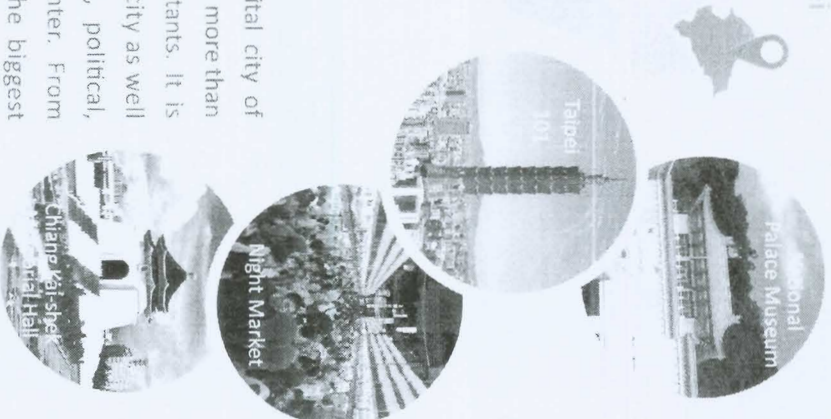
* The accommodation fee of US\$250 will be deducted from the program fee if the student does not apply for accommodation.

All-inclusive Program Fee

The program fee includes tuition, lecture materials, airport transportation service, orientation, accommodation, travel insurance (NTD 1 million for travel insurance and NTD100,000 for accident¹ medical insurance), cultural events, company visits, 1-day tour of Taipei and 4-day field trip. The fee does not include international transportation to Taipei. Students will need to make their own arrangements.

Taipei is the capital city of Taiwan, which has more than 2.5 million inhabitants. It is Taiwan's largest city as well as its economic, political, and cultural center. From skyscrapers to the biggest collection of Chinese art,

Application is first-come first-served and we will not accept any more students when the program has reached its limit.
