#### Admission criteria

## 1. Education:

Graduate of High-school grade 12 or currently studying at grade 12 which is expected to graduate in the 2020 academic year

### 2. Study plan:

- 2.1 Science-Mathematics Program
- 2.2 A minimum of 22 credits of basic and additional science subjects must be taken, at least 12 credits of mathematics, and at least 9 credits of English language
- 3. Cumulative grade point average throughout the course (GPAX):

Not less than 3.00.

### 4. Cumulative Grade Point Average of Learning Subjects (GPA):

Science, Mathematics, English language, not less than 3.00

### 5. Specific qualification:

- 5.1 Thai nationality or be a person legally residing in Thailand and holding a Thai ID card
- 5.2 Being adherent to the democratic regime of government with the King as Head of State.
- 5.3 Not being a corrupt conductor or have been sentenced to imprisonment by the final judgment. In a case that the Commission deems it may bring a detriment to the dignity of educational or training institutions.
- 5.4 Not be a previous dismissal from any educational institution due to improper conduct or is an offense or a joint offense, both academic and non-academic.
- 5.5 Not being eligible for admission to any tertiary education institution due to selection of persons to study bachelor's degree academic Year 2020.
- 5.6 Be a good health and free from disease, symptoms of disease or disability. The committee considered that it may be an obstacle to education, performance, and the practice of medical assistant.

5.7 Good personality height not less than 150 centimeters body mass index (BMI) between 18-30 if not within the specified criteria at the discretion of the board.

## 6. Additional documents that the department required

The committee conducts the selection of applicants who meet all the requirements of the specified criteria to attend the interview by using the portfolio as an important part of consideration, it consists of 4 parts as follows:

- **6.1 Personal statement (20%)**: The length is not more than 2 pages(A4).
  - Reasons for applying for medical emergencies
  - Motivation for wanting to be a paramedic
  - Purpose in life
- **6.2 Activities and Rewards (50%)**: Not more than 20 activities the applicant thinks that it is interesting and valuable. With a brief description of the details:
  - National or international academic award/activities in health sciences or foreign language.
  - Participation in activities related to the profession of paramedic.
  - Participation in activities that promote morality and ethics.
- 6.3 Letter of recommendation from the school administrator or the advisor (15%) commented that why is the applicant suitable to study and practice a paramedic
- **6.4 English language proficiency score (15%):** The exam results are not more than 2 years from the date of application submission. With one of the following English proficiency test results:
  - TOEFL: IBT (Internet-based Test) from 64 points or more (overall)
  - TOEFL: CBT (Computer-based Test) from 173 points or more (overall)
  - TOEFL: ITP (Institutional Testing Program) from 500 points or more (overall)
  - TOEIC from 600 points or more (overall)
  - IELTS from 5.0 points or more (overall)
  - MU-ELT from 84 points or more (overall)
  - CU-TEP from 60 points or more (overall)
  - TU-GET from 500 points or more (overall)

Applicants must prepare a Portfolio in PDF format, uploaded in Mahidol University's online admissions system, along with other supporting documents as specified in Section 7. Selected from 80 percent or more are eligible to take an interview.

## 7. Supporting documents for admission that must be uploaded in the online admissions system

1.1 Digital photograph of the applicant It is a single, straight face without a hat and dark glasses. Wear a polite school uniform, white or blue background.

- size 1.5x2 inches, photographed for up to 6 months and not digitally edited. This image must contain approximately 80% of the face size. It is a .pdf or .jpg file with a width of 180-500 pixels and a height of 200-600 pixels, the file size cannot exceed 240 KB.
- 1.2 Copy of national ID card on the front with card image (Use only on the front side) on A4 white paper. Applicant's signature Last name certified true copy. And scan to file extension.
  - \*If the applicant's name or surname according to the national identity card does not match the transcript. Copy evidence of change of name or surname on A4 paper and scan to file extension .pdf or .jpg, image size equal to A4, file size not over 2 MB, scanned as same file as ID card.
- 1.3A copy of the applicant's house registration on white A4 paper, the applicant's signature name and surname, certified true copy and then scanned into a file extension.
- 1.4A copy of the transcript of High-school grade10-12 issued by the school with the stamp School on white A4 paper and scan as .pdf or .jpg file extension (if there are 2 pages, scan both front and back), the image size is equal to A4, the file size cannot exceed 2 MB.
  - \* If grades are not completed in 6 semesters, the results of 4 or 5 semesters are required.
- **2.** Career that can be assembled after graduation:
  - Practicing paramedic in the bureaucratic system, including the Ministry of Public Health, various medical institutions, and local government organizations.
  - Independent practice as a paramedic in the country and abroad.
  - Practicing paramedic staff at various training institutions across the country.
