



Grant Announcement

Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital in the academic year 2019

1. Principle and Rationale

As the Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital Mahidol University has concerned about the progress of graduate students, the scholarship is established for graduate students who have high potential and be able to dedicate valuable time to support medical instructors for conducting the research as well as obtain result of high quality, publishable at international level.

2. The purposes of the scholarship

(1) To motivate students who have high potential to study at the post graduate levels, which can be considered as the enhancement of competitiveness in each program and also lead to increase the nation's competitiveness.

(2) To subsidize students who are able to spend their full time on performing research and obtain result of high quality, publishable at international level.

(3) To increase the research output with the international standard quality in order to go along with the strategic plans of the faculty.

(4) To support students to become researchers or academics who are able to create the research with the highest quality and utilize their valuable knowledge to improve the faculty.

4. Qualifications of Students Applying for scholarship

4.1 Postgraduate Student

1.	Must be the first year both Thai and foreign students, who study master and doctoral programs, are able to perform research full time during the working day
2.	The average scores for a bachelor degree is not less than 3.25 and 3.5 for master
3.	Must have fulfilled the English proficiency requirement of the Faculty of Graduate Studies.
4.	Must not accept scholarship from other faculties during the period of scholarship.

4.2 International Ph.D. Students with Outstanding Potential.

1.	Must be the first year foreign students studying in a doctoral program and performing research full time during the working day
2.	For International Students who graduated from the institutions of the Memorandum of Cooperation (MOU) with the University will be considered at first.
3.	Should have excellent academic records for previous degree. The average scores of studies in bachelor not less than 3.25 (for the program 3-5 years) and the average score of at least 3.00 (for a course of 6 years). For a master of not less than 3.50. In the case of students who graduated from the institutions with no grading system. The consideration will be depended on the discretion of the Board
4.	With the inclusion of specific subjects in the qualifying examination admission in very good shape, and the English ability must reach the English proficiency requirements of the faculty of Graduate Studies.
5.	For honor students and experienced researchers with high potential will be able to obtain a special consideration.
6.	Must not accept scholarship from other faculties during the period of scholarship.
7.	Must be an immigration legalization.

4.3 Master Degree Student Research Assistant

Qualifications of Students Applying for scholarship	
1.	Must be the first year both Thai and foreign students, who study master programs, are able to perform research full time during the working day
2.	The average scores of studies in bachelor degree is not less than 3.25 and/or finished course work for master with the average scores not less than 3.50
3.	Must have fulfilled the English proficiency requirement of the Faculty of Graduate Studies.
4.	Must have an approval of thesis proposal.
5.	Must not accept scholarship from other faculties during the period of scholarship.
6.	Scholarship students must assist his/her major advisor and publish the research together with his/her major advisor as co-author. The scholarship student must publish their own research in at least national journals.
7.	Must have a certificate from major advisor which elaborates research project being assigned to be research assistants. It must not be the student's thesis proposal.

Qualification of major advisor	
1.	Must have published in peer-review academic journals at the international level in the last 3 consecutive years.
2.	Must have a continue scholarship from outside the faculty. The scholarship must be performed research in the same areas as assistantship.
3.	Must have a laboratory or place for conducting research, including equipment, materials and facilities, available for using by the research assistant.
4.	Must have time available for consultation with the research assistant.

4.4 Doctoral Degree Student Research Assistantships (RA)

The qualifications of students who are eligible to apply for scholarship of the research project called research assistantships (RA) have to be under the terms of the declaration of Graduate College, Mahidol University. The conditions for this academic year have been mentioned below;

1.	Must be Thai or Oversea doctoral students studying in the program which is under the coordination of the Graduate School, Mahidol University who have to pass the thesis proposal examination. The dissertation topic and the appointment of the advisory board have been approved.
2.	GPA has to be at least 3.50
3.	Should show high potential for doing research work, for example, the research has been published or being awarded in the academic/used to receive research grants and so on.
4.	Must have fulfilled the English proficiency requirement of the Faculty of Graduate Studies.
5.	Must not accept scholarship from any other similar or higher value during the scholarship period.
6.	Must propose a research plan for the thesis together with the advisor, and should be able to perform work according to the research plan for the period of the assistantship. Those who are employed must submit a letter from the employer allowing them leave to study and perform research full time during the working day.

5. Evaluation of Research Progress

1. The committee will consider who are eligible receiving the scholarship from the list of prioritized candidates.
2. The list of the candidates will be nominated to the dean in order to get approved and continue to the next steps.
3. The dean's decision is considered as a final process.

6. Termination of assistantship grant

1. Students who receive the assistantship, take their thesis exam obtain a pass result
2. Students who receive a scholarship resigned from the research assistantship program.

3. The results of the evaluation of the thesis appears as the U in 2 consecutive semesters or as the P in 4 consecutive semesters (in accordance with the university education in the academic year 2556 Article 45.12.2)
4. Students receiving assistantships withdraw from student status.
5. Students who receive a scholarship stopped doing research or leave of absence without reasonable grounds.
6. Students declare false information or fail to report the source of funding, which receive apart from the faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital
7. At the end of the scholarship period.
8. Evaluation commissions of each semester have agreed to suspend funding.
9. In cases that are considered beyond the threshold and the requirements which were set out, the dean has the authority to interpret and solve problems with the Implementation of this announcement. This is considered as the final stage.
10. According to university regulation, administrations and Finance 2551 Budget Amendment (No. 2) Act 2556 informed that the disbursement of funds has to be under the announcement for disbursement of the proceeds of the faculty.

7. Obligations and terms of scholarships

Please pay attention to the announcement from the Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital before submitting an application.

1. If the scholarship ceases in any cases which are related to the principles of the scholarships for graduate students 2558, announced on August 18, 2558, Article 10 (2) (3) (4) (5) (6) or. (8), scholarship students who receive any types of scholarship, such as international students with high potential, graduate scholarship and research assistant for master level scholarship are required to pay a sum of 2 times of the funding it receives.
2. In terms of the scholarship payment method, money will be disbursed to students who receive scholarships for international students with high potential, graduate or research assistant at the master level when the contract is signed.

The payment procedure, students will be funded when the contract is completed (if any), or the act as defined in the announcement which is related to the research project called graduate research assistant (RA: Research Assistantships) in the year of the scholarship
