A successful candidate who is accepted to this program will receive a partial scholarship of THB 30,000 from Ramathibodi School of Nursing, Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital, Mahidol University.

Requirements

1. Currently be a Graduate nursing student at Ramathibodi School of Nursing
2. Have good English skills, able to present and write reports in English
3. Achieve a minimum GPA of 3.25 with no "F" in any subjects
4. Have good responsibility, good social skills, and regularly participate the activities at Ramathibodi School of Nursing
5. Have a thesis topic or a thesis proposal in English
6. Able to give an oral presentation of a concept paper or a thesis proposal in English
7. Able to have own financial support
8. Have a Registered Nurse license
