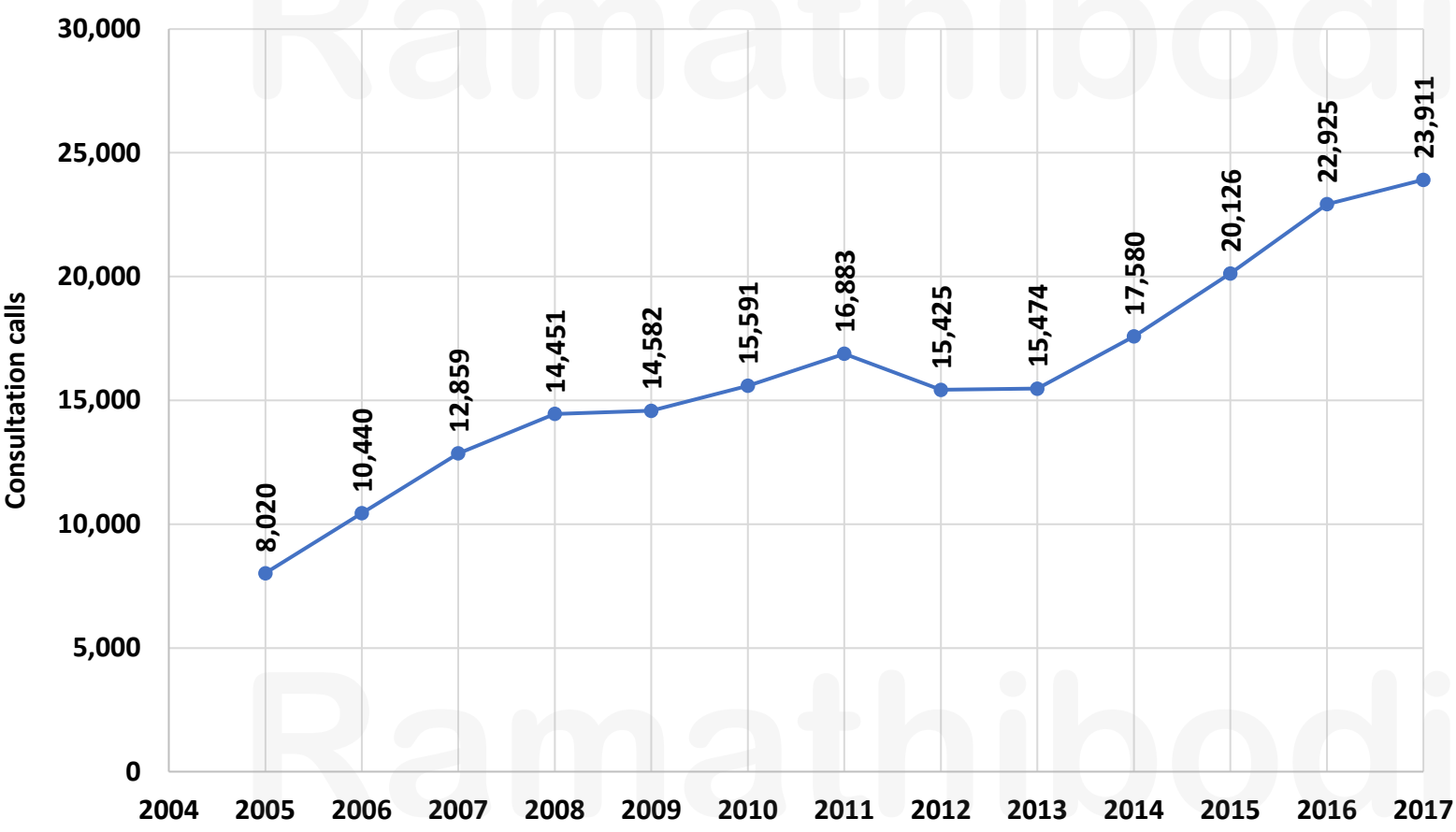
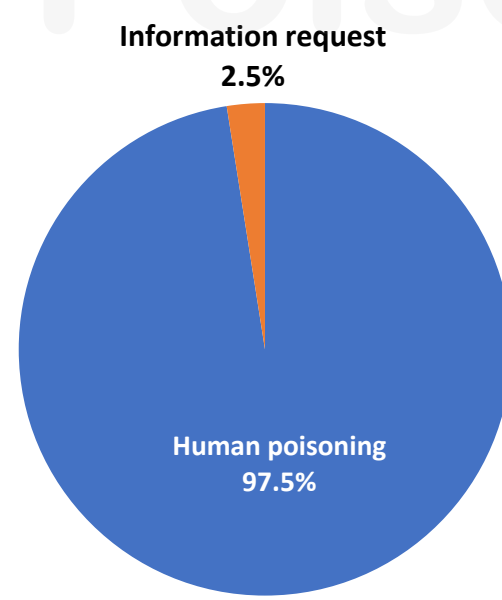

Growth of inquiries from the year 2005 to 2017



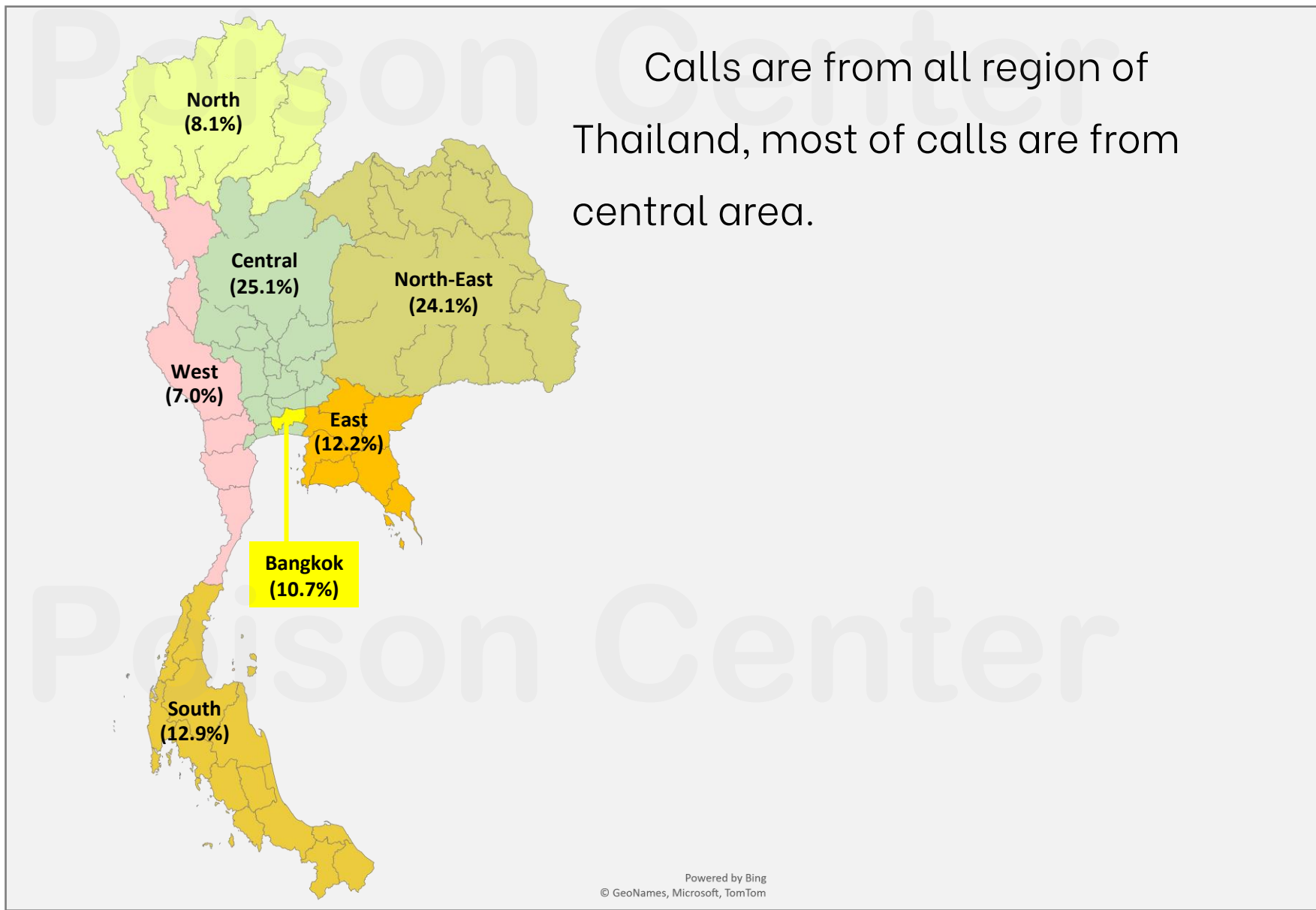
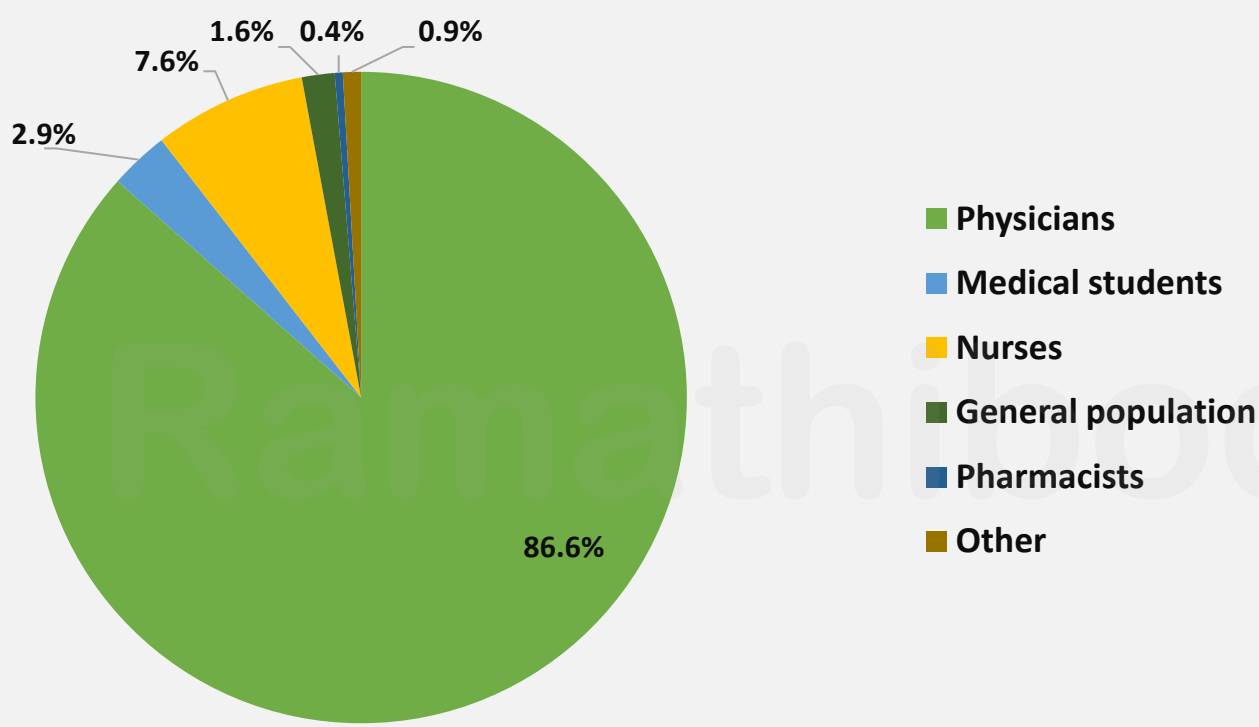
The types of the inquiries (2017)



The numbers of consultation calls to Ramathibodi Poison Center are keep increasing from 2005 to 2017. There is a slightly decrease of calls in 2012 which is explained by changing the phone to 4-digit hotline number 1367.

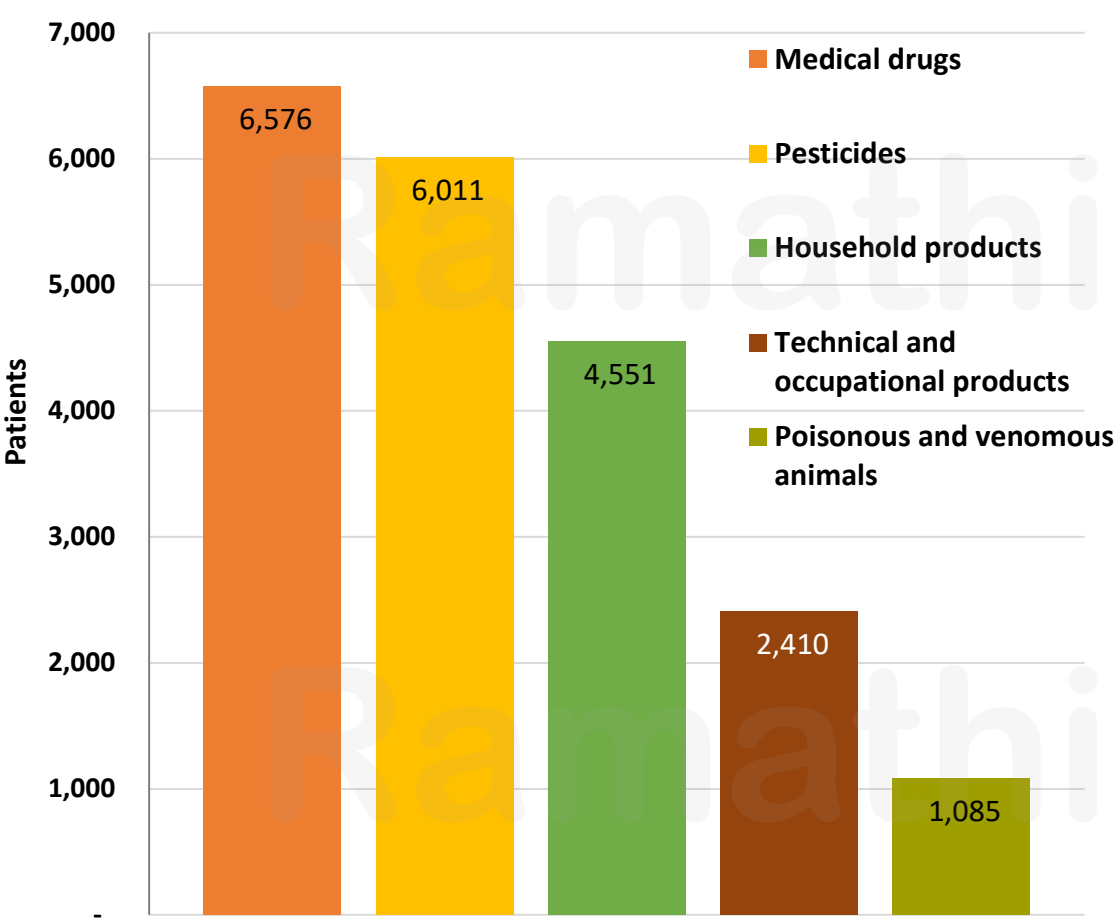
Most of calls (97.5%) are for consultations of human poisoning cases.

More than 95% of calls are from health personnel. The majority of callers are physicians.

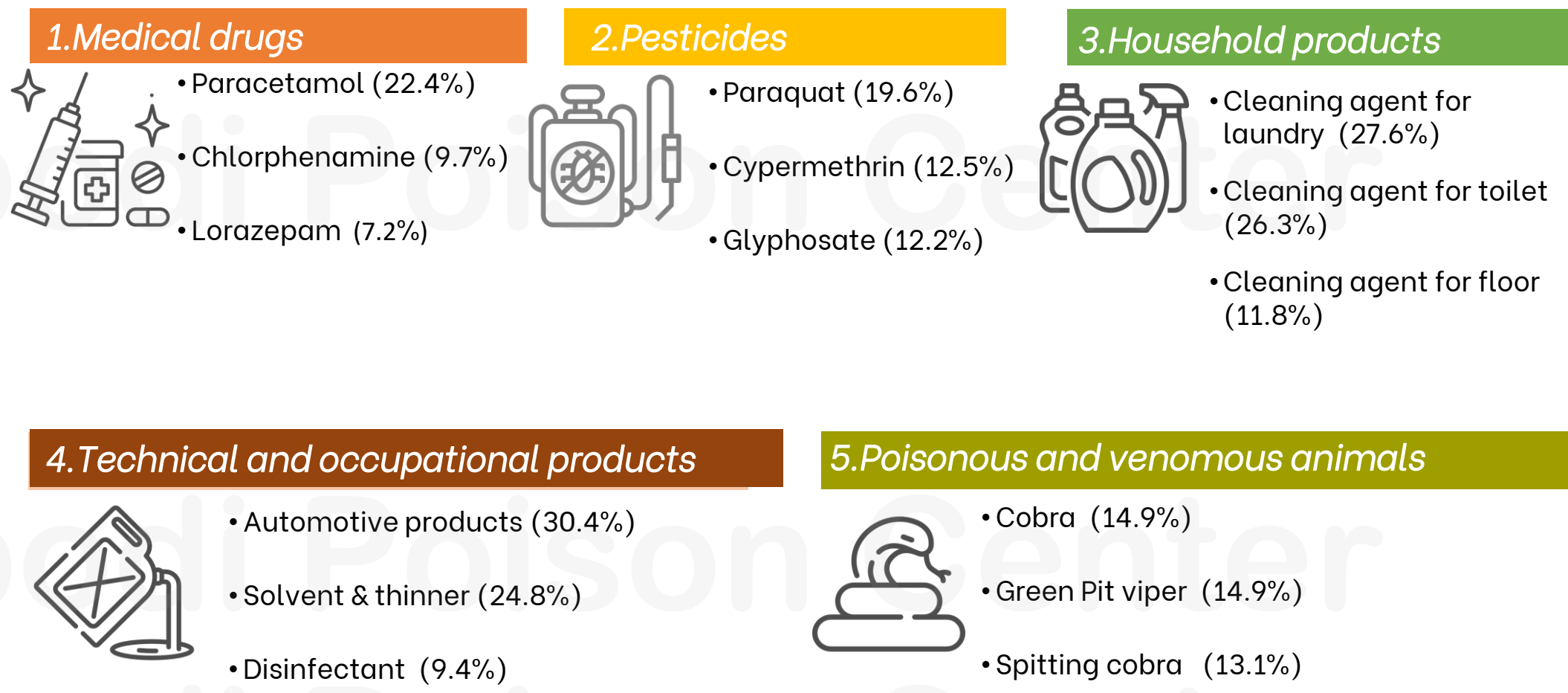


Calls are from all region of Thailand, most of calls are from central area.

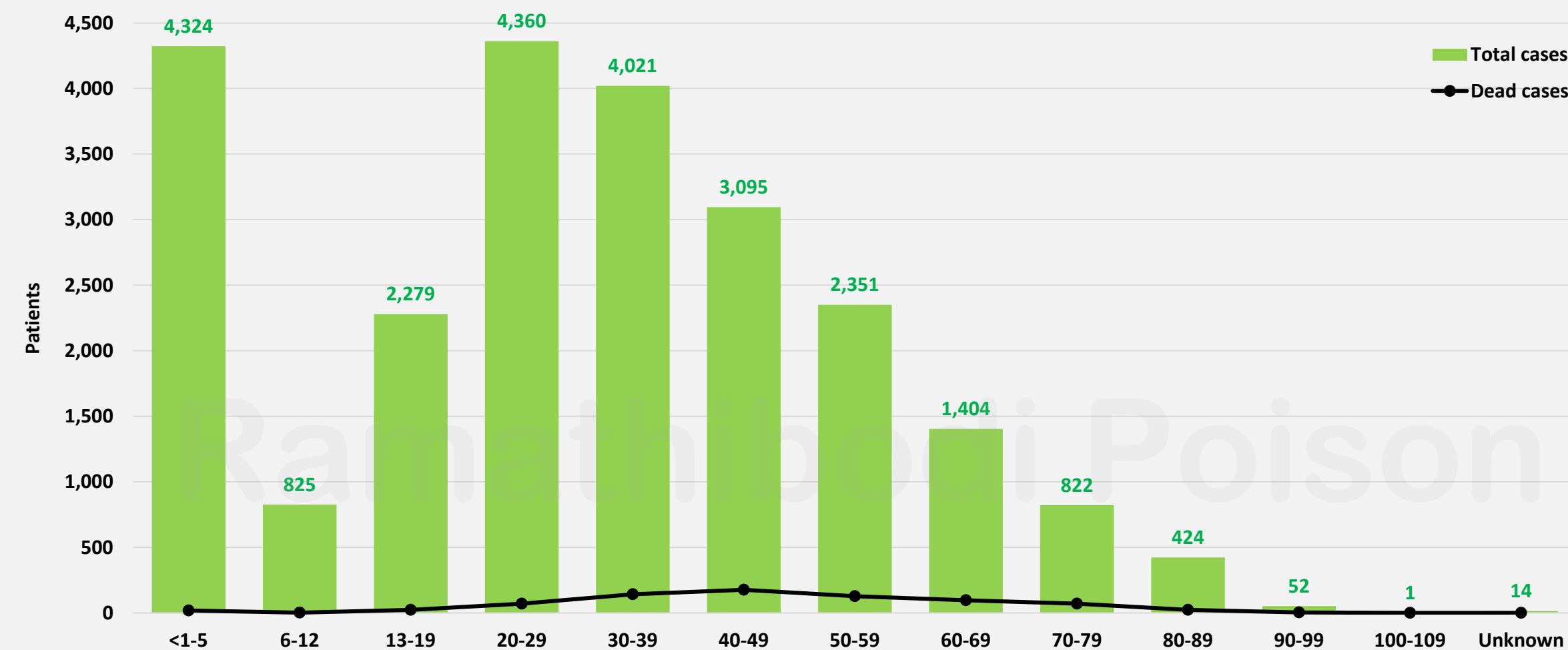
Most common categories involved in human poison exposure



TOP 3 substance in each category of common poisoning

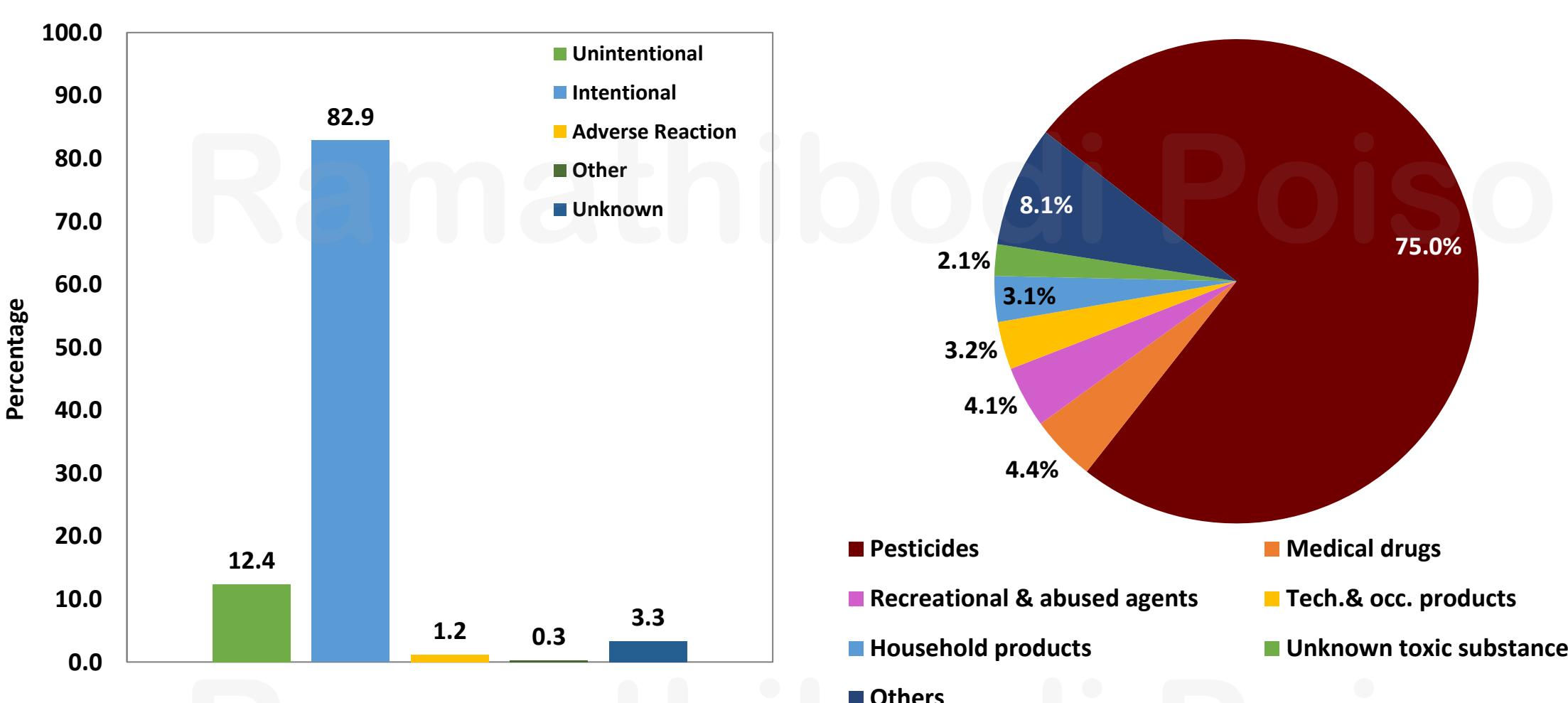


Age distribution compares between poisoning patients and dead cases

The most common substances related to fatal outcome in each category

Category	Substance
1. Pesticides	Paraquat
2. Medical drugs	Methotrexate
3. Recreational & abused agents	Amphetamine derivatives
4. Technical & occupational products	Petroleum distillate
5. Household product	Cleaning agent for toilet
