

- The ingredients
 - 1. The Narrative
 - 2. The Physical Maneuver



5M²: THE 5 MINUTE BEDSIDE MOMENT

1. The Narrative

- Context and usefulness of the maneuver
- A vignette (eg: historical context, genesis of eponym, personal anecdote)
- Interpretation
- Caveats and common errors

5M²: THE 5 MINUTE BEDSIDE MOMENT

2. The Physical Maneuver

- Set up the environment
- Involve the patient and explain what is to be done
- Model gentle and skilled technique
- Model and imitate incorrect technique
- Have the learners "just do it"
- Have the learners teach the technique
