Surgical sepsis protocol

1. **Screening** : REWS ≥ 2 + suspect infection $\xrightarrow{\text{no}}$ supportive +- specific Rx

2. **Diagnosis** SOFA ≥ 2 $\xrightarrow{\text{no}}$ supportive +- specific Rx

3. **Time zero**

Sepsis

3.1 H/C 2 sp

3.2 Appropriate ATB after H/C

within 1 hour

3.3 blood lactate

3.4 Initial IV fluid - Crystalloid 30 cc/kg @ load in 1 hour

4. **Fluid responsiveness (IVC)**

IVC < 2.5 cm or collapse $> 50\%$

IVC ≥ 2.5 cm or collapse $\leq 50\%$

Crystalloid 250 CC load in 15 mins

Up to 4 times
